
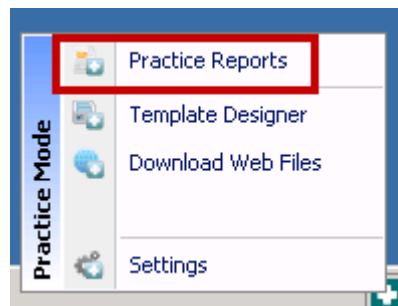


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## High Value Patients Report


If you want to target certain patients for review, Vision+ helps by showing a Value for each patient on the Merge screen, which is displayed in the Value column. These values are calculated using a complex formula based on the projected point totals that can be achieved. Because the values are very small, they are shown to the nearest 1000th of a point.

1. Login to Vision. From the Windows Notification Area, right click on the Vision+ Icon  and select **Practice Reports**.



*Accessing Vision+ Practice Reports*

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 **Note** - To access Practice Reports, you must not have a patient selected in Consultation Manager else the patient-specific menu displays.

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2. The Practice Reports module opens by default on the QOF page.

3. From the QOF screen, choose **High Value Patients**.

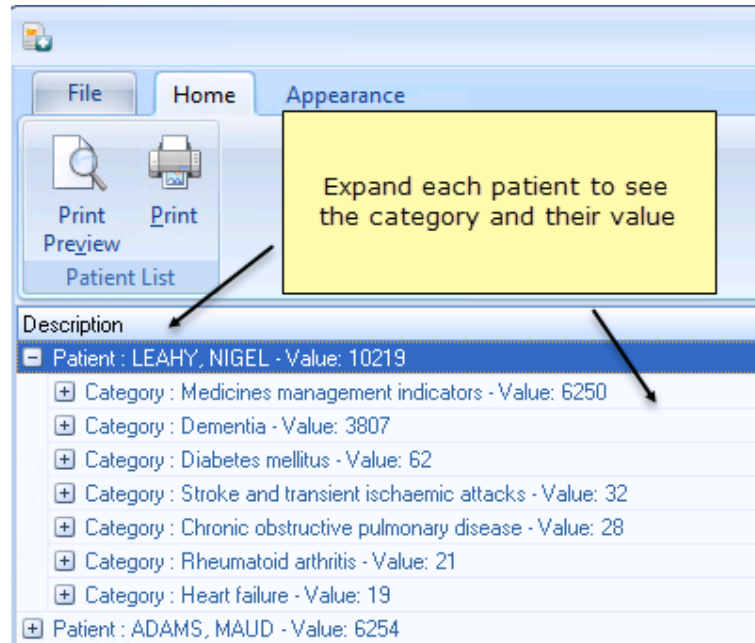

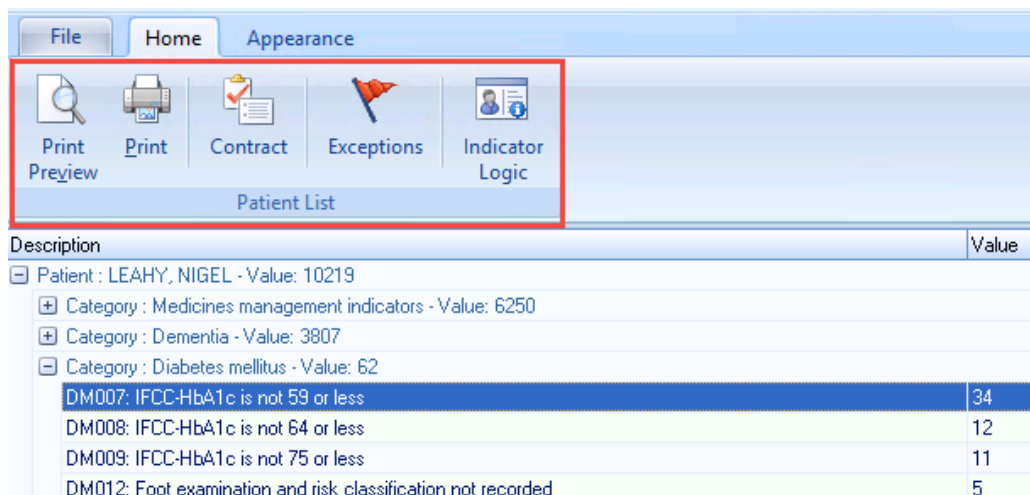

6. If you highlight a specific indicator line you can:



*Working with High Value patients*

- **Print Preview** or **Print** - To print the information
- **Contract** - This allows you to enter the contract information via the data entry tools screen
- **Exceptions** - This enables you to record Exception codes directly into the patient's record
- **Indicator Logic** - This allows you to check the business rules on this indicator and why the patient qualifies

7. Patients who are seen and the data recorded are automatically removed from the report the next time it is run.
